Job Summary	<p>The Assistant Driller supports the Driller in carrying out safe and efficient offshore drilling operations by supervising the drill crew and ensuring compliance with Company procedures, client rules, and well control standards.</p> <p>The role involves providing day-to-day leadership to derrickmen and roughnecks, overseeing drilling activities, equipment preparation, maintenance and repairs, bulk transfers, and maintaining high standards of housekeeping.</p> <p>The Assistant Driller also plays a key role in health & safety by leading safety practices, participating in emergency response and well control drills, supporting risk assessments, and assisting with crew training. In addition, the position supports administrative tasks such as daily drilling reports and operational records.</p>
Role Details	<p>This position is based on one of our semi-submersible drilling rigs, the Borgland Dolphin.</p> <p>The contract in Spain is for 7 firm wells with an option to extend by a further 3 wells. This is followed by a direct continuation of work in the UK (currently under a Letter of Intent) that would see the Borgland Dolphin contracted through to October 2031.</p>

	<p>The offshore rotations for the Borgland Dolphin will be 28 day on/28 day off rotation, whilst in Spain and 21 day on/21 day off rotation in the UK.</p>
