<b>Experience</b>	<p>A minimum of 2 years' experience as a Crane Operator on an operational semi-submersible or drilling vessel is required. Helideck operations and emergency response experience is essential.</p> <p>Lattice boom crane experience preferred.</p>
<b>Job Summary</b>	<p>A Crane Operator is responsible for the safe and efficient operation of cranes on the semi-submersible unit, ensuring all lifting activities are carried out in accordance with company procedures and safety standards.</p> <p>The role involves conducting routine and preventative maintenance on crane equipment, supervising assistant crane operators and deck crew, and supporting overall deck operations.</p> <p>In addition to operational duties, the Crane Operator plays a key role in maintaining a safe working environment by participating in risk management processes, safety meetings, and emergency drills. They are responsible for following training requirements, adhering to regulatory and Company policies, and ensuring the safety and wellbeing of all personnel during lifting operations.</p>
<b>Role Details</b>	<p>This position is based on one of our semi-submersible drilling rigs, the Borgland Dolphin.</p>

	<p>The contract in Spain is for 7 firm wells with an option to extend by a further 3 wells. This is followed by a direct continuation of work in the UK (currently under a Letter of Intent) that would see the Borgland Dolphin contracted through to October 2031.</p> <p>The offshore rotations for the Borgland Dolphin will be 28 day on/28 day off rotation, whilst in Spain and 21 day on/21 day off rotation in the UK.</p>
