Job Summary	<p>The Driller is responsible for safely executing offshore drilling operations on a semi-submersible unit and supervising the drill crew under the direction of the Toolpusher.</p> <p>The role involves directing day-to-day drilling activities in line with the drilling programme, Company procedures, and client requirements, while ensuring well control, equipment readiness, and high standards of housekeeping.</p> <p>The Driller plays a key leadership role in health & safety, compliance, emergency response, and crew training, as well as maintaining accurate drilling reports, pipe tallies, and handover documentation to ensure continuity of operations and effective team performance.</p>
Role Details	<p>This position is based on one of our semi-submersible drilling rigs, the Borgland Dolphin.</p> <p>The contract in Spain is for 7 firm wells with an option to extend by a further 3 wells. This is followed by a direct continuation of work in the UK (currently under a Letter of Intent) that would see the Borgland Dolphin contracted through to October 2031.</p> <p>The offshore rotations for the Borgland Dolphin will be 28 day on/28 day off rotation, whilst in Spain and 21 day on/21 day off rotation in the UK.</p>
