<b>Job Summary</b>	<p>The Able Seaman will support the offshore marine operations by carrying out manual tasks such as cargo handling, cleaning, and routine maintenance, while assisting with inspections and upkeep of equipment.</p> <p>The role focuses on safety, including maintaining lifesaving and firefighting equipment, participating in emergency response duties, and supporting operational activities such as helicopter operations and vessel transfers.</p> <p>Throughout all tasks, the role places strong emphasis on safety, clear communication with supervisors, and adherence to company procedures and permit-to-work systems.</p>
<b>Role Details</b>	<p>This position is based on one of our semi-submersible drilling rigs, the Borgland Dolphin.</p> <p>The contract in Spain is for 7 firm wells with an option to extend by a further 3 wells. This is followed by a direct continuation of work in the UK (currently under a Letter of Intent) that would see the Borgland Dolphin contracted through to October 2031.</p> <p>The offshore rotations for the Borgland Dolphin will be 28 day on/28 day off rotation, whilst in Spain and 21 day on/21 day off rotation in the UK.</p>
