Job Summary	The Senior Barge Supervisor is responsible for the safe, efficient, and compliant management of all marine operations on a mobile offshore unit (MOU), reporting directly to the Offshore Installation Manager (OIM). The role leads the marine team, overseeing ballast control, deck and lifting operations, vessel and helicopter coordination, rig moves, stability management, and emergency preparedness. A strong focus is placed on health, safety, environmental and quality standards, ensuring regulatory compliance, maintaining marine and safety equipment, conducting inspections, and promoting a positive safety culture. The position also provides leadership, coaching, and development of marine personnel while ensuring operational readiness, security compliance, and continuous improvement across marine activities.

Role Details	This position is based on one of our semi-submersible drilling rigs, the Paul B Loyd Junior, which is operational in the UK North Sea. The offshore rotations for the Paul B Loyd Junior will be 21 day on/21 day off rotation.
