Job Summary	<p>This role involves maintaining and repairing mechanical, pneumatic, and hydraulic equipment on an offshore semi-submersible, reporting to the Chief Engineer and supervising Assistant Mechanic/Motorman positions.</p> <p>The Mechanic is responsible for performing routine and reactive maintenance, carrying out daily equipment checks, coordinating with operational teams to minimise downtime, and promptly reporting or fixing faults.</p> <p>Key duties include managing spare parts and tools, maintaining accurate logs and participating in emergency response and drills.</p>
Role Details	<p>This position is based on one of our semi-submersible drilling rigs, the Borgland Dolphin.</p> <p>The contract in Spain is for 7 firm wells with an option to extend by a further 3 wells. This is followed by a direct continuation of work in the UK (currently under a Letter of Intent) that would see the Borgland Dolphin contracted through to October 2031.</p> <p>The offshore rotations for the Borgland Dolphin will be 28 day on/28 day off rotation, whilst in Spain and 21 day on/21 day off rotation in the UK.</p>
