Job Summary	<p>A Roustabout is responsible for carrying out general deck duties on an offshore unit, working safely and efficiently under the direction of the Crane Operator.</p> <p>The role includes maintaining high standards of housekeeping, supporting deck operations such as slinging and signalling crane loads, and assisting the drill crew with drilling-related activities when required.</p> <p>A Roustabout is also expected to participate in helideck operations, emergency response teams, fire and safety duties, and regular drills, while reporting hazards, defects, and incidents.</p> <p>Throughout all tasks, the role places strong emphasis on safety, clear communication with supervisors, and adherence to company procedures and permit-to-work systems.</p>
Role Details	<p>This position is based on one of our semi-submersible drilling rigs, the Borgland Dolphin.</p>

	<p>The contract in Spain is for 7 firm wells with an option to extend by a further 3 wells. This is followed by a direct continuation of work in the UK (currently under a Letter of Intent) that would see the Borgland Dolphin contracted through to October 2031.</p> <p>The offshore rotations for the Borgland Dolphin will be 28 day on/28 day off rotation, whilst in Spain and 21 day on/21 day off rotation in the UK.</p>
