Job Summary	<p>The Senior Electrician is responsible for managing and coordinating all electrical installation, maintenance, and repair activities, reporting to the Chief Engineer and supervising electricians.</p> <p>The role ensures the safe, efficient, and compliant operation of all electrical equipment through planned maintenance, certification, inspections, risk assessments, and electrical isolations. Overseeing work permits and third-party equipment are also part of the role.</p> <p>The position also plays a key role in safety leadership, emergency preparedness, regulatory compliance, crew development, and proactive reporting to minimise downtime and operational risk.</p>
Role Details	<p>This position is based on one of our semi-submersible drilling rigs, the Borgland Dolphin.</p> <p>The contract in Spain is for 7 firm wells with an option to extend by a further 3 wells. This is followed by a direct continuation of work in the UK (currently under a Letter of Intent) that would see the Borgland Dolphin contracted through to October 2031.</p> <p>The offshore rotations for the Borgland Dolphin will be 28 day on/28 day off rotation, whilst in Spain and 21 day on/21 day off rotation in the UK.</p>
