Job Summary	<p>The System Technician is responsible for maintaining, inspecting, and repairing drilling and pipe handling systems onboard, reporting to the Chief Engineer.</p> <p>The role focuses on safe and efficient operation through daily inspections, fault-finding using specialist software, and planned maintenance of instrumentation, electrical, and hydraulic systems.</p> <p>The position supports drilling operations by liaising with the drilling crew and engineering team, documenting and reporting system issues, maintaining equipment records, and minimising downtime through timely maintenance.</p> <p>Strong system knowledge, ability to perform troubleshooting in a busy working environment. Compliance with safety procedures, work permits, and company policies is essential, alongside maintaining high housekeeping standards and actively participating in safety and emergency activities.</p> <p>The position offers you varied tasks in a dynamic working environment.</p> <p>The rig is equipped with a drilling equipment package from HMH (MHWirth).</p>

Role Details	<p>This position is based on one of our semi-submersible drilling rigs, the Borgland Dolphin.</p> <p>The contract in Spain is for 7 firm wells with an option to extend by a further 3 wells. This is followed by a direct continuation of work in the UK (currently under a Letter of Intent) that would see the Borgland Dolphin contracted through to October 2031.</p> <p>The offshore rotations for the Borgland Dolphin will be 28 day on/28 day off rotation, whilst in Spain and 21 day on/21 day off rotation in the UK.</p>
