Job Summary	<p>Requires strong drilling knowledge of semi-submersible rig operations, combined with proven leadership capability with effective people management skills.</p> <p>This role is responsible for the overall supervision and safe execution of offshore drilling operations on a semi-submersible unit, reporting to the OIM. The Toolpusher leads and coordinates the drilling team, ensuring operations follow the approved drilling programme, client requirements, and well-control procedures.</p> <p>The position involves planning and directing daily activities, maintaining equipment readiness and maintenance, enforcing high standards of housekeeping, and promoting effective collaboration with other departments and third parties. A strong focus is placed on HSEEQ leadership, risk management, emergency response, crew competence and training, as well as accurate reporting, record keeping, and performance management to ensure efficient, compliant, and incident-free operations.</p>
Role Details	<p>This position is based on one of our semi-submersible drilling rigs, the Borgland Dolphin.</p> <p>The contract in Spain is for 7 firm wells with an option to extend by a further 3 wells. This is followed by a direct continuation of</p>

	<p>work in the UK (currently under a Letter of Intent) that would see the Borgland Dolphin contracted through to October 2031.</p> <p>The offshore rotations for the Borgland Dolphin will be 28 day on/28 day off rotation, whilst in Spain and 21 day on/21 day off rotation in the UK.</p>
