Job Summary	<p>The Tourpusher is a senior offshore drilling supervisor responsible for overseeing and safely executing drilling operations on a semi-submersible rig, in line with the drilling programme, company procedures, and client requirements.</p> <p>Reporting to the Toolpusher, the role involves leading and supervising the drill crew, ensuring well control and blowout prevention standards are met, maintaining equipment readiness and performance, and coordinating effectively with other departments, contractors, and client representatives. The Tourpusher has strong HSEEQ responsibilities, including leading safety meetings, managing risk assessments, responding to emergencies and well control situations, and supporting crew training and competence.</p> <p>The role also includes key administrative duties, such as ensuring accurate drilling and IADC reporting, maintaining inspection and certification records, and supporting incident and maintenance close-out, with performance measured through safety leadership, teamwork, operational efficiency, and emergency response capability.</p>
Role Details	<p>This position is based on one of our semi-submersible drilling rigs, the Borgland Dolphin.</p> <p>The contract in Spain is for 7 firm wells with an option to extend by a further 3 wells. This is followed by a direct continuation of</p>

	<p>work in the UK (currently under a Letter of Intent) that would see the Borgland Dolphin contracted through to October 2031.</p> <p>The offshore rotations for the Borgland Dolphin will be 28 day on/28 day off rotation, whilst in Spain and 21 day on/21 day off rotation in the UK.</p>
